



Day 8, More Tuscan Splendours: Drive out to Casamonti to visit one of the "Cinta Senese" farms for lunch. The "Cinta Senese" is a special breed of pigs, fed exclusively on acorns. In the afternoon continue to the Nostra Vita Estate for a tasting of the farm's famous Brunello wines. (B, L, Tasting)

Day 9, Departure: Following breakfast and checkout, continue on your onwards journey. Arrivederci! (B)

Day 5, Agrigento — Noto: Depart for Agrigento and enjoy a locally-guided tour of its Doric temples where you'll enjoy a cocktail and buffet lunch. (B, L, D)

Day 6, Modica — Ragusa: Today starts with a visit to Modica, well-known for chocolates, and a stop at Bonajuto's chocolate factory for a tasting. 



PARIS

4 DAYS - 3 NIGHTS



Day 1, Arrive in Paris: Meet & Greet service at airport or railway station and a private transfer to your hotel. Check-in and the day at leisure.



Day 2, City Tour of Lyon: A private, guided half-day tour of Lyon, listed as UNESCO World Heritage site. Discover the Traboules (traditional passages) between buildings. Enjoy a visit to Les Halles Paul Bocuse, the legendary food institute and visit the (Halles de Lyon Paul Bocuse), a unique indoor market. Then ride the funicular to Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière.

Day 3, Cooking Class: Find your way to Chef Stephane's kitchen and enjoy a customized cooking class followed by lunch of the food you have expertly concocted. In the afternoon, ride in the Combi VW collector for a gourmet trip to discover local producers in the region.

GARDEN LOVERS' TOUR

5 DAYS - 4 NIGHTS



Day 1, Meet & greet at Paris Airport for transfer to Giverny. Lunch at leisure. Visit the Jardins de Claude Monet. Transfer to hotel near Rouen. (D)

Day 2, Visit the Jardins des Agapanthes. This 20th century garden is ideal for an intimate stroll, it is distinguished by the originality of its structures, which combine minerals and plants in with great finesse. Then the Clos du Coudray which covers an area of 25 000 m² and is composed of brightly colored flower beds, stone gardens, rocks, a pergola and ponds.(B)(D)

Day 3, Visit the Jardins du Mirosmesnil; the Parc du Bois des Moutiers and the Le Vasterival. The garden, overlooking the site of Vasterival, is a garden of passion and beauty.(B)(D)

Day 4, Free time in Rouen: Let's succumb to the charms of this medieval city. Lunch at leisure in Rouen. Visit the Jardin Plume which was created in 1997 by Sylvie and Patrick Quibel. The Jardin Plume is a stunning contemporary garden combining structure and nature set in a typical Norman orchard..(B)(D)

Day 5, Visit the Jardin d'Angélique: the garden contains over 2000 different varieties of roses. Two gardens each created from scratch: one dreamy, romantic, where grassy paths wind between beds rich in subtle colours; and one Italianate, with box-edged beds of perennials and ornamental grasses, punctuated by yew topiary. Lunch at leisure. Departure to the airport.

CASTLE HOTELS

(SELF-DRIVE)

9 DAYS - 8 NIGHTS



Château de Gilly, Gilly-lès-Cîteaux

Day 1, Paris — TGV - Strasbourg: In the morning, experience the most recent Train à rande Vitesse, (TGV - high-speed train) connection to Strasbourg, reaching the capital city of Alsace. Pick-up your car at Strasbourg Gare Centrale, then familiarize yourself with the city before checking into the Château de l'Ile, an eclectic and picturesque 19th century castle.

Day 2, Strasbourg — The Wine Road — Colmar — Rouffach: Driving along the Alsatian Wine Trail and discover the charm of the wine-growing villages such as Obernai, Ribeauvillé, Riquewihr. Stop at the mountaintop Château de Haut-Koenigburg to experience the atmosphere of the Late Middle Ages before heading to the old town of Colmar. Retire to the elegant Château d'Isenbourg.

Day 3, Rouffach — Franche Comte — Vougeot (Burgundy): Departing Alsace you'll drive through the Franche Comté region, bordering Switzerland. First stop: Belfort with it's pentagonal wall built by Louis XIV's military architect. And then onward to Montbéliard. Your journey ends in Burgundy's Vougeot and the beautiful 16th century Château de Gilly.

Day 4, Vougeot Beaune & Dijon Vougeot (Burgundy): Today is your day to tour Dijon, City of Dijon mustard! And more than mustard, Dijon supplies spice for the eyes with its toits bourguignons — polychrome, graphic-patterned roofs made of terracotta tile glazed in red, green, yellow and black. After the tour, return for a second night at the beautiful Château de Gilly.

Day 5, Vougeot — Route Des Grands Crus: Cote De Beaune & Cote De Nuits - Vougeot: Today you are on the Route des Grands Crus, to tour Burgundian vineyards including Côte de Beaune and the Côte de Nuits.

CASTLE HOTELS (cont.)

(SELF-DRIVE)

9 DAYS - 8 NIGHTS

Day 6, Burgundy — Vezelay — Fontainbleau — St. Sephorien Le Château: Bidding farewell to the Château de Gilly, you're off through Avallon to Vézelay's 12th century Abbaye Sainte-Marie-Madeleine de Vézelay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It holds the relics of the revered Saint Mary and was a starting point for medieval pilgrims en route to Santiago de Compostella. Then move north, passing Auxerre. Near Nemours, you could easily side-trip to the forest and Château of Fontainebleau. Passing through, you'll reach tonight's resting-spot, the fairytale-like Château d'Esclimont (built 1543) in St. Sephorien le Château.

Day 7, St. Sephorien Le Chateau — Chartres — Orleans/Blois — Tours: Today, visit Chartres with it's world-famous cathedral, the most beautiful and largest in Europe, then Orléans or Blois, both royal domains from the 10th and 15th centuries. Tonight you will stay at the elegant Château d'Artigny in Montbazon, just south of Tours.

Day 8, Montbazon — Chambord — Chenonceau — Montbazon: This morning you travel to the Château de Chambord, with its fantastic roofscape of towers, cupolas, gables, lanterns and chimneys. Begun in 1518 by François I, it's reputed to have been designed by Leonardo da Vinci. Then it's a short drive to the refined Château Chenonceau, a mid-river château spanning the Cher. This residence of the wives and mistresses of kings and nobility reflects a feminine influence and has retained its delicate late-Renaissance style. From Chenonceau it's a short drive back to Château d'Artigny for a second luxurious night.

Day 9, — Montbazon — Villandry — Tours — TGV Paris: From Montbazon, drive to Villandry, the last great French Renaissance château built in the Loire Valley; or to Azay le Rideau, designed to look like a Gothic fortress (26 km from Tours). Drive back to Tours to drop off your rental car at the TGV station and high-speed-it back to Paris.
